Level 4 Maths Booster groups

- 94% of children who accessed Maths Booster groups achieved Level 4 by the end of Key Stage Two.
- 31% of children who accessed Maths Booster groups were in receipt of Pupil Premium
- 100% of children in receipt of Pupil Premium who accessed Maths Booster groups achieved Level 4 by the end of Key Stage Two

Level 6 Maths Tutor groups

- 80% of children who accessed Maths tutor groups achieved Level 6 by the end of Key Stage Two
- 20% of children who accessed Maths tutor groups were registered for Free School Meals
- 100% of children in receipt of Pupil Premium who accessed Maths tutor groups achieved Level 6 by the end of Key Stage Two

Level 4 Writing Booster groups

- 100% of children who accessed Writing booster groups achieved Level 4 by the end of Key Stage Two.
- 40% of children who accessed Writing booster groups were in receipt of Pupil Premium.
- 100% of children who were in receipt of Pupil Premium who accessed Writing booster groups achieved Level 4 by the end of Key Stage Two

Level 4 Reading Booster groups

- 92% of children who accessed Reading booster groups achieved Level 4 by the end of Key Stage Two
- 45% of children who accessed Reading booster groups were in receipt of Pupil Premium.
- 100% of children in receipt of Pupil Premium who accessed Reading booster groups achieved Level 4 by the end of Key Stage Two

Better Reading Partnership

- 94% of all children accessing Better Reads achieved Level 2b or above by the end of Key Stage One
- 50% of children who accessed Better Reads were registered for Free School Meals
- 88% of children in receipt of Pupil Premium who accessed Better Reads achieved Level 2b by the end of Key Stage One

Level 2 Writing Booster groups

- 100% of all children accessing Writing intervention groups made good progress
- 56% of all children accessing Writing intervention groups made accelerated progress
- 56% of children who accessed Writing intervention groups were in receipt of Pupil Premium
- 56% of all children accessing Writing intervention groups achieved Level 2 or above by the end of Key Stage One
- 50% of children in receipt of Pupil Premium who accessed Writing intervention groups achieved Level 2 or above by the end of Key Stage One
